


When did the investigators demand / request interviews from the involved officers?

Did the IHIT Investigators meet faceto-face with the involved officers before they went off duty?










What was the quality of the interviews of the involved officers?

Were experts retained to provide an opinion on any aspect of this case and if so, were they truly independent?






Were Mr. Dziekanski's steps that day retraced?




